Position Summary: Responsible for working with program participants to ensure progress toward training and employment goals. Coordinates and instructs assigned activities based on the Individual Advancement Plan. Facilitates web/software development learning program. Provide technology job skills training to those who are most in need, primarily young adults, age 17-29, with barriers to employment. Facilitates web/software development learning program, leading to the successful certification of program participants.

Position Responsibilities & Duties:

- Work with TechHire Coordinator and coaches to ensure facilitation and instruction coverage for participating students and identify and address students' learning needs.
- Host office hours, including in-person/live student/class support and web conferencing
- Work with TechHire Coordinator to flag and improve out of date material and to refine curriculum based on employers' needs.
- Provide real world work experience and expertise to students, preparing them for paid internships and employment.
- Provide constructive feedback and motivate students as they work on their assignments.
- Create a learning environment and experience leading to the successful completion and certification of program participants.
- Other duties as assigned.
