Admission Requirements

- ✔ Must be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent resident.
- ✔ Must be a High School graduate/GED/HSED.
- ✔ CMN does not currently accept International students.
- ✔ Home school applicants will be considered on an individual basis.

Step 1. Apply Online

Visit our website at www.menominee.edu to submit your online application. Click the **Apply Here** tab on the upper right corner of the webpage.

Step 2. Admission Documents

Admission Documents Required

- Tribal Enrollment verification (if applicable)
- High School Transcripts and College Transcripts
- Accuplacer Placement Test or ACT Scores

Step 3. Schedule an Accuplacer Placement Test

Placement testing is an admissions requirement for all High School and New First-Time Freshman students. The requirements for Transfer and Returning student is determined on an individual basis.

Step 4. MyEmpower Account

MyEmpower is an online student portal to monitor and track your Admissions and Financial Aid statuses. You will receive your username and password when your admissions application is submitted.
